SCOUT ISLAND CANOE SPECIALIST

BASIC FUNCTION:

Under the direction of the Director, Scout Island Outdoor Education Center, lead the development and safe implementation of a canoe program for students; provide students with a fun, positive outdoor learning experience; maintain high standards of safety, health and cleanliness during canoe and other activities.

REPRESENTATIVE DUTIES:

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

- Develop and supervise all aspects of canoe program for students accessing the Scout Island Outdoor Education Center.
- Create and lead fun canoe games, skill building sessions and nature-exploration activities.
- Assist with orientation and on-going canoeing training to assigned personnel.
- Load and unload canoes; clean and maintain canoes and equipment
- Clean Scout Island Outdoor Education Center area as needed/assigned.
- Comply with schedules, policies, regulations, procedures, orders, and directives of the County Superintendent.
- Exhibit professionally appropriate interpersonal skills including but not limited to tact, patience, flexibility, and courtesy.
- Maintain a safe work environment.
- Operate a variety of office equipment, including but not limited to a computer and assigned software applications.
- Serve as a liaison between County Superintendent and administrators, personnel, outside organizations or the public concerning assigned area.
- Serve as a technical resource concerning assigned program, function, or instructional area.
- Work collaboratively and maintain effective working relationships with others in the course of work in assigned area.

- Theoretical and technical aspects of field of specialty.
