



Naloxone (Narcan) Volunteer Training Annual Notification

FROM: Fresno County Superintendent of Schools

TO: All FCSS Staff

Pursuant to Education Code 49414.3, the Fresno County Superintendent of Schools hereby provides annual notice to all staff that it requests volunteers from among its employees to be trained and willing to administer Naloxone (Narcan) to students experiencing an opioid overdose at any FCSS facility. Volunteers will receive training in:

- a. An ability to identify the signs of an opioid overdose
- b. An ability to identify where Naloxone nasal spray units are stored at relevant school site(s)
- c. A Knowledge of Roles-
 - i. Who will manage other students
 - ii. Who will stay with an overdosing student (keep safe, recovery position)
 - iii. Who will retrieve medication
 - iv. Who will administer medication
 1. Procedure for proper dosage(s)
 2. Procedure for proper administration of medication
 3. Procedure to dispose of utilized nasal spray units
 - v. Who will call school nurse and parent (when the medication is administered)
 - vi. Who will call 911
 - vii. Who will stay and monitor student after medication administered/complete charting
 1. Place student in recovery position
 2. Call student's private physician
 - viii. Who will accompany the student to the ER

Volunteers must be currently certified in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and be willing and physically able to administer Naloxone (Narcan) to persons identified as experiencing or reasonably believed to be having an opioid overdose. Volunteers will be provided a defense by the County Superintendent of Schools against "any civil action or proceeding" brought against them, in their official capacity or individual capacity or both, "on account of an act or omission in the scope of" their employment as an employee of the Fresno County Office of Education, in accordance with that provided in Government Code §§ 995 and 996. Volunteers may rescind their consent at any time.
